

Payment Policy

Welcome to Cascadia Women's Clinic. We are happy you have chosen us for your pregnancy care. This letter is to explain our payment policy for your OB care and delivery.

We will verify your maternity benefits with your insurance company to determine what your estimated out of pocket cost will be for your pregnancy. This amount generally includes your deductible and co-insurance. Your estimated out of pocket amount will need to be paid by the beginning of your eighth month of pregnancy so we will set you up on an OB payment plan that will allow you to make monthly payments towards this amount and help alleviate any large bills from Cascadia after you deliver. Once we have verified your benefits, you will receive a letter that will show the estimated amount due broken down into monthly payments ending your eighth month.

This estimated amount due is based on our fee for vaginal delivery which includes routine OB visits, delivery and postpartum visit(s). It does not include additional services such as urinalysis, blood draw, lab work, ultrasounds, non-stress tests, etc. It also does not include any hospital charges you incur. This amount is also subject to change based on complications of pregnancy, method of delivery, etc.

We look forward to caring for you and your baby.
